MUNICIPAL COMMITTEE OKARA INVITATION FOR BIDS

1. The Government of Pakistan has received a Loan (Credit No. 6243-PK) from the International Development Association (IDA) for funding of Punjab Cities Program (PCP) and intends to use part of the funds to eligible expenditures under the contract for sub-projects mentioned below. The program will be implemented under the control of Punjab Municipal Development Fund Company (PMDFC).
2. The Bidding is open to all the eligible bidders in line with PPRA Rules and according to the category of their enlistment with Pakistan Engineering Council (PEC) and Local Government of Sahiwal Division for the financial year 2022-23.
3. Sealed bids are invited from eligible bidders for the following sub-projects (No.CE(North)PLGB(9)-TS/2022-Lahore Dated 09.12.2022):

Bidding Documents will be available immediately after publications of this notice and can be purchased from Office of Municipal Officer (Infrastructure), Municipal Committee Okara for a non-refundable fee of Rs. 10,000/- for each set up to 02-01-2023. Interested bidders may obtain further information (including the qualification criteria) from the Office of the Chief Officer Municipal Committee Okara.
 5. Bids shall be valid for a period of 90-days after Bid opening and must be accompanied by bid security of amount mentioned above in the form of a Bank Draft or an Irrevocable en cashable on-demand Bank Call Depositing favor of Chief Officer Municipal Committee Okara and shall be submitted on or before 02-1-2023 at 2:00 P.M. in the office of Chief Officer Municipal Committee Okara.
 6. The bids shall be opened by the Tender Opening Committee in the presence of the bidders or their authorized representatives who choose to attend at 02:30 P.M. on 02-1-2023 day at the above given office.
 7. A pre-bid meeting with contractors will be held on 27-12-2022 at 02:00 P.M. in the office of Municipal Officer (Infrastructure), Municipal Committee Okara and interested bidders are invited for participation.
 8. The Bidding Procedure will be governed by Rule 38(2)a of PPRA Rule 2014 "Single Stage Two Envelopes" procedure wherein the bidders will be required to submit Technical & Financial Bids in Separate envelopes properly marked and both sealed in one envelop. The Technical Bids shall be evaluated on the basis of qualification criteria provided in the bidding documents. The bidders are required to include the letter of awards and the completion certificate of the similar works completed by them or in hand presently in the Technical Bid along with other qualification information asked for in the bidding documents along with documentary evidence. This information shall be used to establish whether the bidder is qualified to perform the work or not. The Financial Bids of only those bidders will be opened who qualify in the Technical Bids.
 9. Bids are required to be submitted on item rate basis (not on the basis of MRS with percentage premium) and the rates and amounts must be filled by the bidder for each item in the Bill of Quantities and quote the total price.
 10. Bidders should give their best and final price in their Bids as no negotiations are allowed.
 11. The Competent Authority reserves the right to reject all Bids, as per Punjab Procurement Regulatory Authority (PPRA) Rules (2014).
